PRESS RELEASE FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE

The Supervisors of the Checklist of Salem New Hampshire will be in session on Saturday, October 25, 2008 between 10:00 AM and noon on the lower level of the Municipal Office Building for the purpose of registering new voters for the upcoming Presidential/ State General Election. This will be the last opportunity for a person to register to vote if he/she wants their name to appear on the checklist that will be used on Tuesday, November 4, 2008. New Hampshire election law does, however, allow a person to register to vote on election day at the polls if they present required documentation.

Perspective new voters need to be 18 years of age. A picture ID and proof of domicile is required. (A drivers license is acceptable.) Naturalized citizens must show a passport or documented citizenship papers.

A presently registered voter may make changes or corrections to their name, address, or political party affiliation at this session. Residents may also register to vote at the office of the Town Clerk during regular office hours through Friday, October 24, 2008. Copies of the checklist are available at either the Kelley Library or the Municipal Office Building.
